The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.52 dated 28.02.2008, registered under Section 363, 366, 120-B IPC, Police Station Bhuna, District Fatehabad.

The FIR was registered by Inder Singh when his 16 year old daughter went missing from the house. The complainant had named the petitioner.

Counsel for the petitioner urges that it was a case of consent and girl was major and trial against one accused had ended in acquittal and he was ready to join the investigation. He states that accused was declared proclaimed person and he had no notice. He also states that girl is with the petitioner and was living happily.

The petitioner is a proclaimed person. He had kidnapped the minor girl . The police could not recover the girl. Now after 8 years he has approached the Court seeking anticipatory bail. A proclaimed person is not entitled to anticipatory bail.

The petition is dismissed.

Petitioner would surrender within a week.
