The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in cross case of case/FIR No.46, dated 24.3.2016, registered under Sections 354, 323, 294, 506, 148, 149 of the IPC and Section 8 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012, at Police Station Division No.2, Jalandhar.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that in CRM-M

to the accused in the main FIR on the ground that the matter was between close family members, and prays that on the basis of parity, the present petitioner be also granted the same concession.

Learned DAG Punjab, on instructions from ASI Narinder Singh has accepted the fact that the accused in the main FIR were granted bail on the ground that both the parties were close family members and the matter had been compromised.

In this view of the matter, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of regular bail to the petitioner. Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
