Learned counsel for the petitioner has pointed out me the judgment dated 14.07.2015 passed in Sessions case No.28 dated 23.03.2015 which shows that for the same offence in which the petitioner is in Jail, the other co-accused have been acquitted. The petitioner could not be tried as he was declared Proclaimed Offender, but then he has been arrested on 17.03.2016. In such a situation, only way is to direct the learned trial Court to complete the trial of the petitioner particularly in view of the earlier trial held in which the other co-accused have been acquitted.

Learned State counsel states that charge(s) would be framed today before the trial Court.

In that view of the matter, trial Judge is directed to complete the trial within a period of 2 months from today.
