There is delay of 2 days in filing the present appeal. The appellant has filed an application under Section 5 of the Limitation Act for condonation of delay.

Heard on the application.

In view of the reasons mentioned in the application, same is allowed.

The present appeal has been preferred against the award dated 06.05.1998, passed by learned Motor Accidents Claims Tribunal, Jagadhri, (hereinafter called the Tribunal), vide which the claim petition filed by the appellant-claimant under Section 166 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 for grant of compensation on account of injuries suffered by

him in the motor vehicular accident which took place on 31.12.1994, has been dismissed by the learned Tribunal.

2. This fact is not disputed that the respondent was driving the vehicle, wherein the appellant-claimant was travelling, on the basis of the authority given by the claimant himself, who was the owner of the vehicle. Meaning thereby, the respondent was just the agent of the appellant-claimant.

3. Learned counsel for the appellant has not been able to point out any serious illegality in the impugned award which can warrant the interference by this Court.

4. Thus, the present appeal has no merits and the same is hereby dismissed.
