Petitioner seeks concession of regular bail in a case registered on the basis of a trap having been laid to determine the culpability of the petitioner under Pre-Conception and Pre-Natal Diagnostic Techniques (Prevention of Sex Selection) Act, 1994. The allegation against the petitioner is that mandatory provisions of Pre-Conception and Pre-Natal Diagnostic, Techniques (Prevention of Sex Selection) Rules, 1996 have been violated by not maintaining proper record.

ASI Pritam Singh informs that after the arrest of the petitioner, police remand of one day was obtained and thereafter, the petitioner had been sent to judicial custody on 25.06.2016. The petitioner has been in custody with effect from 25.06.2016. No useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner in custody during the entire period of trial.

Petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on her furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Shri Muktsar Sahib.
