Learned State counsel on instructions from HC Joga Singh, Police Station NRI Kapurthala submits that the police has withdrawn Kalandra under Section 66 of the Punjab Police Act against the present petitioner which was pending before the ACJM, Kapurthala as well as challan and that though the police has submitted cancellation report before the concerned Court but the same has been rejected by the Court and has placed on record photostat copy of the same, which is taken on record.

The petition stands disposed off with a direction to the official respondents that they will not intrude into the privacy of the petitioner and put him to harassment by repeatedly calling him to the

Police Station. In case the petitioner is required in any proceedings by the police they shall serve a clear seven days' notice in writing upon the petitioner to allow him to have legal recourse.
