Prayer made in the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the official respondents to conduct fair investigation by some independent agency at State Headquarter level or through premier agency in a criminal complaint submitted to Respondent No. 3 and 4 against the Police Official respondents No. 5 to 6 and other two unidentified persons for kidnapping/disappearance and causing beating and injuries to Salman aged 21 years old son of the petitioner.

Learned State counsel has filed reply on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 4, by way of affidavit of Saurav Jindal, PPS, Asstt. Commissioner of Police (East), Ludhiana. The same is taken on record.

As per the reply, FIR No.97 dated 28.04.2016 for offence under Section 379 IPC Police Station Div No.7, Ludhiana has been

registered against unknown persons for snatching a purse of one Pooja Sharma and during investigation, it was suspected that the son of the petitioner, namely, Salman has committed the said offence, therefore, Salman, son of the petitioner was joined investigation in the said FIR on 04.05.2016, but his involvement was not found in the crime and thereafter, he was let off immediately and was never harassed.

In view of the above, the prayer of the petitioner for grant of fair investigation has meticulously been met with. The present petition stands disposed of accordingly.
