JASPAL SINGH, J

This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, "Cr.P.C.") seeking directions to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner as well as her family members at the hands of respondents No. 4 to 15.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner further contends that though representation (Annexure P-2) was moved to Deputy Commissioner, Ludhiana but no action has been taken.

3. At this juncture, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner should be allowed to move a fresh application to Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana unfolding all the facts contained in representation (Annexure P-2), which could be dealt with and disposed of by him.

5. The present petition is disposed of by allowing the petitioner

to move appropriate application/representation before the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana within a period of one week from today, which shall be dealt with and disposed of by the concerned authority(s) within a period of two months from the date of receipt of application/representation, in accordance with law.
