Present in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for
issuance of directions to respondents No. 1 to 3 to protect the life and
liberty of the petitioner and further not to harass him.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that the
petitioner is being harassed by the respondent-police authorities at the
behest of respondent No.4, namely, Gurinder Singh son of Surjit Singh.

On the other hand, learned State counsel has contended that in
FIR No.63 dated 28.07.2016 for offence under Section 420 IPC registered
at Police Station Div. No.8, Ludhiana, petitioner has been named as an
accused and the matter is pending investigation under the supervision of
senior officers.

At this stage, Mr. Davinder Bir Singh, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of respondent No.4 and filed Power of Attorney in Court today which is taken on record.

Taking into consideration the fact that the petitioner has been named as an accused in the FIR, the prayer of the petitioner is no more survives.
