Quashing of FIR No.14 dated 5.2.2014 under Sections 498-A/406/323/34 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar, District Sangrur, is being sought on the basis of statement dated 10.9.2014 (Annexure P-2)

The F.I.R was registered against the petitioners due to misunderstanding between the parties. After registration of the FIR, complainant made a statement that she compromised the matter and does not want to take action against the accused.

The statement dated 10.9.2014 made by the petitioner (Annexure P2) is not disputed by the counsel for the complainant and even the Investigating officer HC Pinjore Singh.

Parties are present in the Court today and they have been identified by the Investigating Officer.

Consequently, in view of the status report and in view of the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of ***Dr. Arvind Barsaul etc. versus State of Madhya Pradesh and another 2008(2) RCR (Criminal) 910***, no useful purpose would be served in prolonging the litigation.

Accordingly, FIR No.14 dated 5.2.2014 under Sections 498-A/406/323/34 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar, District Sangrur, is quashed along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom qua petitioners.

The petition stands disposed of.
