By virtue of this petition preferred under Section 482 of Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner-Kabal Singh has sought direction to respondents No.1 and 2 for withdrawal of the investigation in case bearing FIR No.147 dated 27.08.2013, under Section 15 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Canal Colony, Bathinda, District Bathinda even from respondents No.3 and 4 and to transfer the same to some other district or some Independent Agency or Crime Branch.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Sidamkeet Singh Sandhu, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. Copy of the petition is supplied by learned counsel for the petitioner.

It has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that though the representation (Annexure P-4) dated 21.04.2016 was moved to Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda in the matter but till date no action has been taken. Moreover, his son, namely, Sona Singh has

been falsely nominated and implicated just to cause harassment to him by getting the instant case registered at the instance of respondent No.5.

Learned counsel for the petitioner feels satisfied in case the matter is got inquired into at the level of Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda and to take an appropriate action. Accordingly, the petition is disposed of with direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda to inquire into the allegations unfolded in the representation (Annexure P-4) dated 21.04.2016 and if some substance is found, to take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. If the petitioner still feels dissatisfied, he shall be at liberty to approach this Court again.
