In FIR No.0076 dated 13.05.2016 registered under Section 420 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Division No.3, Jalandhar, District Jalandhar City, the petitioners are being prosecuted.

Mr. Himanshu Chabbra-learned counsel for the complainant states that now a compromise has been arrived at between the parties and the same is annexed as Annexure P-2. I have perused the compromise deed-Annexure P-2.

This Court vide order dated August 05, 2016 had directed the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate to record the statements of the parties in view of the compromise and verify that whether the same is genuine or not.

Now, there is a report received from PCS, ACJM, Jalandhar, showing that the statements of the parties have been recorded and

compromise that is arrived at between the parties with the intervention of the respectable persons is genuine and without any pressure, coercion or undue influence.

Looking to the nature of the offence registered in FIR and terms of the compromise deed, I think, parties should be allowed to compound/compromise the offence in order that they live in peace and harmony.

In that view of the matter, FIR No.0076 dated 13.05.2016 registered under Section 420 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Division No.3, Jalandhar, District Jalandhar City is quashed by way of compounding/compromise along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.
