Petitioners had paid a sum of Rs. one lac to Deepak Kumar Jain for managing favour from the police for Darshan Kumar (Depot Holder), Satnam Singh and petitioners who are owners of Ambay Shakti Flour Mill as they were accused in an FIR under Section 411 IPC. Petitioners appear to be victim of Deepak Kumar Jain who has been granted the concession of pre-arrest bail by a Coordinate Bench of this Court on 03.12.2015.

Petitioners as per the instructions of ASI Baljinder Kumar have already joined investigation. Since the victims have been arrayed as accused to the prosecution it seems to be an uphill task to establish their culpability on the basis of the evidence. The FIR in the present case was registered on 03.10.2015. Mere receipt of secret information will not be sufficient enough to establish the culpability of the petitioners.

In view of above circumstances, the petition is allowed. It is ordered that in case of arrest of petitioners, they will be released on

bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer subject to the condition that petitioners will join investigation as and when required and will not tamper with the evidence or hamper the investigation in any manner.
