Present petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No. 138 dated 26.06.2014 (Annexure P-1) registered under Sections 323/427/452/148/149 of the IPC at Police Station Moga, District Moga and subsequent proceedings arising out of aforementioned FIR on the basis of compromise.

Report dated 03.03.2016 of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Moga has been received.

The learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Moga, after recording the statement of the complainant-Harsh Palta, and accused Sumit Sehgal and Gagandeep Sehgal, has reported that the parties have compromised the matter and that the compromise is genuine and voluntarily made.
