The prayer in the instant petition is for direction to the respondent No.2 to investigate the matter in Annexure P-1 dated 11.05.2016, fairly, properly and expeditiously without any further delay.

The grievance of the petitioner is that she was married with respondent No.5-Dalbir Singh son of Darshan Singh on 06.02.2012 according to sikh rites. After her marriage one female child was born on 21.10.2012. Her husband was in France. On 16.01.2013, he came back to India and thereafter, went back to France on 01.04.2013. Again on 08.10.2014 one male child was born to the petitioner. The petitioner was not being supported by her husband and in-laws and having no source of income to maintain herself and both children, she moved an complaint to NRI Police Station. Wherein in-laws family was called and with the intervention of DSP Lakhbir Singh, the matter was compromised on 23.07.2015 (Annexure P-2) with the understanding that respondent No.6 would renovate his old 2 marla house in the same village and will hand over to petitioner for residence. The respondent No.6 had taken further undertaking to pay Rs.10,000/- as monthly expenses for petitioner and her children namely Gurpreet Singh age above 2 years and Daljit Kaur daughter more than 4 years of age. But thereafter, petitioner was harassed, tortured and many time beaten at the hands of respondents No.5 to 8 for

bringing more dowry and big car. Being aggrieved, she filed representation before SSP Kapurthala on 11.05.2016 but no action has been taken in this regard. Hence, the petitioner approached this Court for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 to 4 for the aforesaid reasons by way of this petition.

In view of the above, SSP Kapurthala-respondent No.4 is directed to look into the representation and take appropriate action in accordance with law.

Disposed of.
