

Surjit Kaur and anr. Vs. Jajpal Singh

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As per the statement of the respondent as well as his counsel recorded on 16.02.2016, respondent had agreed to pay an amount of ₹1,25,000/- (₹ One Lac Twenty Five Thousand Only) to appellant No.1 – Surjit Kaur, over and above the amount of compensation already awarded by the MACT, in the terms that out of this enhanced amount, he (respondent) would pay an amount of ₹75,000/- on or before 01.03.2016 and the remaining enhanced amount of ₹50,000/- would be paid by him (respondent) to appellant No.1 – Surjit Kaur on or before 21.04.2016.

Pursuant to the order dated 16.02.2016, on 01.03.2016, two demand drafts bearing Nos.882648 and 882651, both dated 01.03.2016, for ₹40,000/- and ₹35,000/-, drawn on State Bank of Patiala, in favour of Surjit Kaur w/o Sohan Singh, had been handed over by respondent – Jajpal Singh to Surjit Kaur – appellant No.1. For remaining payment of the amount, the case was adjourned for today.

Today, two bankers cheques bearing Nos.179420 and 179421, both dated 21.04.2016, for ₹25,000/- each (in total ₹50,000/-), drawn on State Bank of Patiala, Chandigarh, Punjab, in favour of Surjit Kaur w/o Sohan Singh have been handed over by respondent – Jajpal Singh to Surjit Kaur – appellant No.1.

In view of the above, the appeal stands disposed of as settled.

Copy of the order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the Hon'ble High Court.
