Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.110 dated 15.07.2015 under Sections 22 of NDPS Act, Police Station Sadar Dhuri, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the allegation against the petitioner is recovery of 12 bottles of Rexcof containing 100 ml. each, which is marginally over and above the commercial quantity. He states that the petitioner is in custody since 15.07.2015. He relies upon a judgment of this Court in **Manpreet Singh Versus State of Punjab-2015(1) R.C.R. (Criminal) 102** to substantiate his contentions.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from H.C. Tarsem Lal, does not dispute the custody. However, states that the contraband recovered from the petitioner is commercial. He further states that in one case, petitioner has been admitted on bail and in another, she is facing trial.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

The alleged recovery of 12 bottles of Rexcof containing 100 ml. each, is marginally higher than the commercial quantity. The petitioner is in custody since 15.07.2015. The trial will take sufficient long time and no purpose would be served to keep the petitioner in custody.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is admitted on regular bail subject to furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of CJM/Duty Magistrate, Sangrur.

It is made clear that in case, the petitioner is found involved in any case of similar nature, prosecution will be at liberty to seek cancellation of her bail in the present case.
