The petitioner seeks anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, in cross version recorded in FIR No.149 dated 18.12.2012, registered under Sections 307, 323, 325, 148 read with Sections 34 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Bhogpur, Distt. Jalandhar.

Contents that the petitioner was admitted to bail by this Court vide order dated 23.04.2015. Thereafter, the petitioner had been regularly appearing before the trial Court. The petitioner had to go abroad to meet his ailing uncle. The petitioner had put it to the notice of his counsel, who failed to bring this fact to the notice of the Court. The absence of the petitioner is not wilful and deliberate.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of the Court, Ms. Harsimrat Rai, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice. A complete copy of the paper book is handed over to learned State counsel, in the Court.

In the circumstances, in case, the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court within a week from today, he will be admitted to bail subject to furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds, to its satisfaction. The petitioner shall also surrender his passport and shall not leave the country without written permission of the Court.
