After arguing at some length, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be allowed to withdraw this petition with liberty to raise all his pleas before the trial court at an appropriate stage. He further submits that petitioner is 60 years old lady and goes to the court on each and every date of hearing. Personal appearance of the petitioner may be exempted.

Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.

In case, petitioner moves an application for exemption of her personal appearance, same shall be considered by the trial court in accordance with law. The trial court may exempt the personal appearance of the petitioner on such terms and conditions as it deems proper to impose. Petitioner may be allowed to appear through her counsel except on the dates when her presence is necessary.
