This is third petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.118 dated 6.3.2015, under Section 460 IPC, registered at Police Station City, Fatehabad.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Darshan Singh states that the case of the prosecution is at the fag end of its conclusion. He states that as against the total 17 witnesses cited by the prosecution, as many as 16 witnesses have already been examined and the case is now fixed for 4.8.2016 for the evidence of the Investigating Officer.

Considering the advanced stage of the trial, no case for grant of regular bail to the petitioner is made out.

Dismissed.

In view of the advanced stage of the trial, the trial Court is directed to conclude the trial preferrably within four months from the date of issuance of certified copy of this order.
