Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner-Hari Singh son of Shri Ajit Singh, in case FIR No.7 dated 18.01.2010 under Section 489-A, 489-B, 489-C, registered at Police Station Jalandhar Cantt., District Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegation against the petitioner is that he along with other co-accused are indulged in business of counterfeit currency and in consequence thereof, 20 fake currency notes of ₹500/- denomination were recovered from the co-accused of the petitioner. He states that initially the petitioner was granted bail, but on account of jumping of bail, he is in custody since 29.01.2016.

Learned State counsel has filed the custody certificate of the petitioner in court today which is taken on record. He does not dispute the aforesaid fact. However, he states that as per record as many as 7 other FIRs were registered against the petitioner through he is on bail in all the

cases except FIR No.331 of 2015, under Section 379 IPC, P.S. Civil Lines, Amritsar in which he is on production warrant.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

The petitioner is in custody since 29.01.2016. The trial will take sufficient long time and even prosecution evidence has not yet started. Accordingly, the petitioner is admitted on regular bail subject to furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of CJM/Duty Magistrate, Jalandhar. Taking into consideration the various cases registered against petitioner, the trial Court would be well within its purview to impose any other condition which it may deem fit.

It is made clear that in case, the petitioner is found indulged in any other case of similar nature, prosecution will be at liberty to seek cancellation of his bail.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
