This petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C is for grant of regular bail to the petitioners in case F.I.R No. 128 dated 21.04.2016, under Sections 323/354/506 IPC and Section 3 (5) of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, registered at Police Station Beri, District Jhajjar.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that out of three accused named in the FIR, one (Ram Mehar) has been granted bail by the Additional Sessions Judge, Jhajjar, vide order dated 12.07.2016.

While granting regular bail to Ram Mehar, it has been observed that the injuries were sustained only by one members of the complainant party i.e. Sanjay son of Prahlad Singh and he was also discharged on the same day.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Suresh Kumar,

has informed the Court that even Balwan has been granted regular bail.

Heard.

Keeping in view the period of incarceration of the petitioner(s) and the fact that trial may still take some time for its conclusion, this court feels that there is no need to detain the petitioner(s) any longer. Accordingly, this petition is allowed and petitioners are ordered to be enlarged on bail to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Jhajjar.
