The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.240, dated 12.10.2013, registered under Sections 307, 336, 427, 148, 149 of the IPC and Section 25/27 of the Arms Act, at Police Station Beas, District Amritsar.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner was regularly appearing before the Court but could not appear on one date i.e 13.5.2016 because he noted a wrong date.

Learned Addl. AG Punjab states that she is not aware of these facts since the IO has not come present.

In my opinion, it would be in the interest of justice, if the petitioner appears before the trial Court on 3.8.2016, and if the assertion that the petitioner has not previously misused the concession of bail is found to be correct, the trial Court shall release him on bail to its satisfaction. Ordered accordingly.
