JASPAL SINGH, J.(ORAL)

This is a petition under Section 439 of Code of Criminal Procedure preferred by Deepak, seeking regular bail, during the pendency of the trial, in case bearing FIR No.274 dated 08.05.2016, under Sections 2-D, 3, 4, 5, 6, 9(4), 9(6) and 23 of P.C. PNDT Act and 420 of Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Assandh, District Karnal.

As per the case of prosecution, the petitioner is alleged to be present at the time of raid conducted by a party consisting of different members headed by the Deputy Chief Medical Officer, Karnal but he is stated to have slipped away from there. However, the statements of some other persons were recorded. Petitioner was arrested in this case on May 07, 2016. Though, he was subjected to custodial interrogation yet nothing could be recovered from him to connect him with the allegations complained of against him. Investigation is already complete and report under Section 173(2) has already been presented in the Court. Moreover, petitioner is a student. The offence complained of against the him is

triable by the Magistrate. Otherwise also, the trial is not likely to mature in the near future.

Taking into consideration the aforesaid aspects of the case but without expressing any opinion on merits, petition is allowed and petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing requisite bail bonds at the satisfaction of the concerned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.
