The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.98, dated 18.4.2013, registered under Section 22 of the NDPS Act, at Police Station Tanda, District Hoshiarpur.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner has been facing the trial of this case for the last more than two years and has never misused the concession of bail. On 3.6.2016, she could not attend the Court because she had wrongly noted the date as 13.6.2016 and that

is why non-bailable warrants have been issued against her.

Learned Addl. AG Punjab states that the issue regarding the previous appearance of the petitioner before the trial Court is not in the knowledge of the Investigating Officer.

In these circumstance, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of bail to the petitioner. The petitioner is directed to appear before the trial Court on 11.8.2016 and in case the assertion that she has not previously misused the concession of bail is correct, the trial Court shall release her on bail to its satisfaction.

This petition stands disposed of.
