Petitioner was not named in the FIR but was nominated on the basis of supplementary statement. Similarly circumstanced, co-accused, Amanpreet Singh has been granted the concession of bail by this Court. On the principle of parity, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the CJM/Area Magistrate concerned subject to the condition that petitioner will not in any manner indulge in similar activity during the pendency of the trial and will not, directly or indirectly, make any attempt to threaten the prosecution witnesses. In case of violation of any of the conditions, it will be open to the

complainant to approach this Court for cancellation of bail.

This order is not intended to be read as precedent for the co-accused of the petitioner.
