Kuldip Singh, J. (Oral):

The petition is for quashing of FIR No.254 dated 11.4.2015, registered under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471, 167 & 120-B IPC, at Police Station Civil Lines Karnal, along with all consequential proceedings.

Report of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Karnal received. Learned Magistrate has recorded the statements of the parties and has reported that they have effected compromise voluntarily, without any threat, pressure or coercion and the same is genuine. Attested copies of statements of both the parties have been annexed with the report.

Since the parties have effected compromise, therefore, FIR No.254 dated 11.4.2015, registered under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471, 167 & 120-B IPC, at Police Station Civil Lines Karnal, along with all consequential proceedings stands quashed.

The petition is accordingly allowed.
