This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.48 dated 20.05.2015, registered under Sections 307/452/148/149 IPC and section 25/27 of Arms Act, at Police Station Gidderbaha, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

The allegations against the petitioners were that they were went inside the house of the complainant and three of them shot at the complainant, who was sitting in the balcony.

Learned counsel has argued that as per the FIR pistol shots were fired and three injuries on the person of the father of the complainant are

simple injuries. She has further argued that three assailants were armed with pistols and the size of the injuries are also bullet injuries and there can be no chance being pellet injuries.

Learned Additional Advocate General on instructions from ASI Balwinder Singh Singh states that 13 people attacked the house of the complainant.

In the circumstances, I do not deem it appropriate to dismiss the petition. Let the petitioner appear before the Investigating Officer on 04.08.2016 between 10.00 a.m. To 4.00 p.m. and on any other date on which his appearance is so required by the investigating officer. On his appearance the investigating officer shall grant him interim bail.

Petition stands allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
