1. Whether Reporters of local papers may be allowed to see the judgment?
2. To be referred to the Reporters or not?

AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to respondents No. 1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and not to harass them at the instance of respondent Nos.4 to 7.

The petitioners have got married against the wishes of their parents. They are stated to be major. In support of his proof of age petitioner No.1 has placed on record a copy of Aadhaar Card (Annexure P-1) wherein his year of birth is mentioned as 1985 and petitioner No.2 has also placed on record a copy of Aadhaar Card (Annexure P-2) wherein her year of birth is mentioned as 1996. They have also moved a representation before the Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala (Annexure P-5) for protection of their life and liberty.

Without adverting to the merits of the controversy, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2, the Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala to take appropriate action on the said representation (Annexures P-5).

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
