The petitioner has filed this second petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.191 dated 26.09.2015 registered under Sections 420 & 120-B IPC at Police Station City Ferozepur, District Ferozepur.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

Learned State counsel upon intrusions from the IO has pointed out that from the petitioner various sale deeds in respect of purchase of properties have been seized and they were purchased from the money that was received from the investors. Obviously the money is involved in the crime.

The present matter relates to big fraud, forgery and cheating related to the poor and gullible investors who had parted with their money and have lost their money. There is also no explanation as to the huge amount with which the above said properties have been purchased.

In that view of the matter the concession of anticipatory bail cannot be made available to such petitioner. Accordingly, the petition for anticipatory bail stands dismissed.
