Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of petitioners at the hands of private respondents i.e. respondents No.4 to 7.

Learned State counsel has submitted a report along with statements of respondents No.5 and 6, who are mother and brother of petitioner No.1 respectively, wherein it has been stated that they have no objection even if the petitioners have solemnized the marriage. The said report and statements of respondents No.5 and 6 are taken on record.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition and the same is accordingly disposed of.

However in case, the petitioners still apprehend any threat to their life, they are at liberty to approach the Senior Superintendent of Police concerned for redressal of their grievance.
