JASPAL SINGH, J.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he may be allowed to withdraw the instant petition on behalf of the petitioners No.3-Karnail Kaur w/o S. Harchand Singh, No.9-Hardeep Singh s/o Harchand Singh and No.10-Bachittar Singh s/o Ajaib Singh.

In view of submission made by learned counsel for the petitioners, instant petition is dismissed as withdrawn qua the petitioners No.3-Karnail Kaur w/o S. Harchand Singh, No.9-Hardeep Singh s/o Harchand Singh and No.10-Bachittar Singh s/o Ajaib Singh.

This petition has been preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of cross version in FIR No. 10, dated 14.01.2010, under Sections 326, 324, 451, 427, 34 of IPC, registered at Police Station Payal, District Ludhiana (Annexure P-2) along with all consequential proceedings arising out of the same on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-3).

2. In compliance of order dated July 22, 2015, statement of the parties have been recorded by the trial Court. Report of learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Payal, has been received, in which, it has been categorically observed that parties have arrived at compromise with their free will, without any pressure or coercion from any quarter. Even otherwise, matter involved is personal in nature, which has been amicably put at rest.

3. In view of the above I am of the considered opinion that continuation of criminal proceedings between the parties would be an abuse of the process of law and the present compromise is for their benefit and will bring peace and harmony between them.

4. Consequently, instant petition stands allowed and cross version in FIR No. 10, dated 14.01.2010, under Sections 326, 324, 451, 427, 34 of IPC, registered at Police Station Payal, District Ludhiana and all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are quashed qua the petitioners No.1, 2 & 4 to 8.
