The present petition has been filed under Section 482

Cr.P.C. for quashing of F.I.R. No.211 dated 28.11.2013 registered under

Sections 384/388/420 IPC (Section 25/27 of Arms Act added

subsequently), at Police Station Canal Colony, Bathinda and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

As per this FIR the petitioner first embroiled the complainant in a salacious relationship and then blackmailed him and somehow or the other induced him to part with about Rs.27.00 lacs and gold to save him from a police case. There is also a secondary issue. The petitioner has also raised the complaint that the complainant being a powerful person not only was successful in lodging this false FIR but also got the petitioner arrested and the petitioner was tortured in police custody.

After extensive arguments from the counsel for the petitioner, the counsel for the complainant, Deputy Advocate General and the counsel appearing on behalf of the CBI the following agreed order is passed :-

- (i) As regards the quashing of FIR it has been agreed that before any final report is submitted the entire material will be put up before the IG Bathinda Zone for his approval.
- (ii) The petitioner would be at liberty to seek alternate remedy with regard to the allegations of torture which he has levelled against the police.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
