This petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short 'the Cr.P.C.) for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondent Nos.4 to 7.

As per office report, notice could not be issued to the private respondents for want of process fee. Neither respondent No.4 caused representation on the last date of hearing nor the reply has been filed by the State. Further, as per the record on file the petitioners are major and there is no legal impediment to their marriage and they have solemnized marriage. Their marriage is opposed by respondent Nos.4

to 7.

Without expressing any opinion with regard to validity of marriage and on the merits of the assertions made in the petition, the instant petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2- Superintendent of Police, Ambala, to consider and decide the application dated 02.07.2016 (Annexure P-5) of petitioner No.1 and provide necessary protection to the petitioners, if he is satisfied that the life and liberty of the petitioners is threatened at the hands of respondent Nos.4 to 7, in accordance with law.
