Heard.

At this stage, there is no necessity of issuing notice of motion in the matter. The interest of the petitioners can be safely protected by issuing a direction to the State to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner.

Accordingly, respondent No.2 is directed to treat the present petition as representation and take appropriate action as per law.
