This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.135 dated 25.03.2016 registered under Sections 148/149/323/506/307 IPC at Police

Station Gharaunda, District Karnal.

As per the FIR the petitioner and other accused first caused injuries to Rahul and when the family members of Rahul were taking him to the hospital they were again attacked and this time serious injuries were given to Virender.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has argued that the petitioners have been attributed only simple injuries and apart from the two petitioners three other persons from the accused side also received injuries in the same incident but those have not been explained at all in the FIR. The petitioners are in custody 29.3.2016.

Learned Deputy Advocate General, on instructions from the Investigating Officer has accepted these facts.

Learned counsel for the complainant states that petitioner No.2 have also given injuries to the main injured Virender.

Keeping in view the above allegations and the period of incarceration already suffered by the petitioners, without going into the

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merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to release the petitioners on regular bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Ordered accordingly.

Petition stands disposed of.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
