Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.PC is for quashing the proceedings pending in the Court of learned Additional Sessions Judge, Amritsar in case FIR No.201 dated 8.5.2010 under Section 4/5 of the Explosive Substances Act, 1908, Section 13 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967 and Section 472 IPC registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Amritsar.
