Present application is for impleading Anil Kumar as respondent No. 2. The said application is dismissed. However, respondent-State shall proceed according to law, if they have prepared the challan in FIR No. 183 dated 26.9.2007 registered under Sections 364-A, 382, 420, 467, 468 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act.

On 1.9.2016 permission was granted to the petitioner to go abroad (Australia) for one month. Today, the said person is present in person in Court.

Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, in a case arising out of F.I.R No. 57 of 29.6.2016 registered

under Sections 498-A, 406, 323, 420 IPC, registered at P.S. Bareta,
District Mansa.

Vide the order dated 3.8.2016, this Court granted the bail to
the petitioner and she has joined the investigation on 13.8.2016. The son
of the petitioner and grand daughter of the complainant both are married
and nothing is recovered from them.

In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances of the
case, order dated 3.8.2016 passed by this Court is made absolute. The
petitioner shall continue to join the investigation as and when required to
do so and abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2)
Cr.P.C

However, the petitioner is at liberty to file fresh bail bonds
after presentation of the challan.

Accordingly, the petition stands disposed of.
