Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, namely, Saurabh Gupta in case FIR No.1551 dated 17.11.2015 under Sections 120-B, 406, 420, 467, 468, 471 and 506 IPC registered at Police Station City Panipat.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Kulbir Singh, submits that pursuant to order dated 2.8.2016 of this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no more required at this stage.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigation and conclusion of trial is likely to take sufficient long time, the present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner order dated 2.8.2016 is made

absolute.

However, if required, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
