Prayer in this application is for placing on record the medical record of the petitioner i.e. Annexures P-4 to P-8.

For the reasons stated in the application, same is allowed and the medical record of the petitioner i.e. Annexures P-4 to P-8 are taken on record.

CRM-M-24206 of 2016

Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.44 dated 28.4.2016, under Sections 307, 325, 324, 323, 341, 506, 148 and 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar, Kotkapura, District Faridkot.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that though the

petitioner has been named in the FIR but no specific injury has been attributed to him. The only allegation against the petitioner is that he stopped the motor-cycle of the complainant and raised lalkara. He is in custody since 29.4.2016 and the challan in the case has been presented. He further states that the petitioner is a patient of heart disease and has been referred from Dayanand Medical College and Hospital, Ludhiana to PGI, Chandigarh for getting treatment.

Learned counsel for the complainant states that the presence of the petitioner has made all the differences as he raised the lalkara encouraging the co-accused to cause injuries.

Learned State counsel has also made the similar submissions as of learned counsel for the complainant.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

The challan in the case has already been presented and the trial will take sufficient time. The petitioner is in custody since 29.4.2016. No specific injury has been attributed to the petitioner. The only allegation against the petitioner is that he raised the lalkara. Accordingly, the petition is **accepted**. The petitioner is admitted on regular bail on furnishing of his bail bonds and surety bonds subject to satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Faridkot.
