The petitioner had been granted concession of interim regular bail vide order dated 21.12.2015 by the Coordinate Bench. I do not find any ground to cancel the said interim bail as there does not appear to be any circumstance indicative of the fact that the petitioner has misused his liberty. Petitioner has undergone incarceration for the period of about 14 months as undertrial while his co-accused, in similar circumstances, has been convicted under Section 304 Part II IPC.

Petition is allowed. It is ordered that petitioner will remain on bail against the bail bonds already furnished, subject to a condition that he will not tamper with the evidence in any manner.
