The instant petition has been preferred under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in FIR No.118 dated 23.06.2015, registered under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468 and 471 of the Indian Penal Code, at P.S. Sadar Ludhiana.

Contents that the allegations pertain to the year 2010-11, whereas, the FIR came to be registered on 23.06.2015. The amount allegedly was paid by Narinder Pal Singh, Malkiat Singh, Kala Singh, Reena Rani, Amarnath Singh and Rajbinder Singh but they are not the complainants whereas one Manvinder Singh is the author of the present FIR, who is not the aggrieved person.

On the other hand, learned State counsel, on instructions, states that the petitioner is involved in four other similar FIRs. She was earlier declared a proclaimed person.

Heard.

Considering the fact that the alleged transactions pertain to the year 2010-11, whereas, the FIR came to be registered on 23.06.2016, the main accused is the husband of the petitioner and she is in custody since 11.03.2016, without adverting to the merits of the instant case, this petition is allowed. The petitioner be admitted to bail during the pendency of the trial, on her furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds, to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Ludhiana.
