A fresh status report by way of affidavit dated 29.02.2016 of the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Fazilka, District Fazilka has been furnished in Court today and the same is taken on record. Copy stands supplied to the counsel for the petitioner. Para 3 of the affidavit reads as follows:

“3. That there are total six accused of the FIR in question. Three accused namely Jassa Singh, Dalip Singh and Kala Singh have been arrested by the police on 20.12.2015. The accused Buta Singh has died. Remaining accused Balbir Singh and Malkiat Singh have joined the investigation on 18.01.2016 with the directions of this Hon'ble High Court issued in their bail petitions.”

In the light of such report and averments made in para 3, counsel appearing for the petitioner states that he would not be pressing the instant petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. wherein prayer was to conduct a fair and impartial investigation in FIR No.204, dated 26.08.2014, under Sections 365/323/506/148/149 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar

Fazilka, District Fazilka.

Petition is disposed of as not pressed.
