AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner from respondent No.6.

The case of the petitioner is that he is being harassed by respondent No.6 who is his daughter-in-law with a view to grab his property. In this connection he has moved two representations to the SSP, Kapurthala one of them is Annexure P-3 but till date no action has been taken thereon. He has further stated that at this stage he would be satisfied if a direction is given to respondent No.2-SSP, Kapurthala to look into the matter and decide his representation within any reasonable time.

I find this to be a fair request. The respondent No.2-the Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala is directed to look into the matter/representation (Annexure P-3) and take whatever action he deems necessary as per law expeditiously.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
