Having been summoned as accused in the exercise of powers under Section 190 Cr.P.C., by the Area Magistrate, pursuant to the interim orders, the petitioners have already put in appearance before the summoning Court.

Mr.Rajesh Kumar Girdhar, Advocate, has intervened on behalf of the complainant to oppose the application for pre-arrest bail.

I have considered the facts and circumstances of the case and I am of the opinion that petitioners had earlier been declared innocent during the course of investigation and having put in appearance before the trial Court pursuant to the interim orders, they can be provided the protective umbrella to prevent detention during the course of trial.

The petition is allowed. It is ordered that the petitioners will remain on bail against the bail bonds already furnished by them before the trial Court subject to the conditions that they will continue to appear before the Court and will not absent themselves without any sufficient cause.
