By virtue of the instant petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioners have sought issuance of directions to respondents No. 1 to 3 to protect their lives and liberty at the hands of respondent Nos. 4 & 5 as they feel apprehension of danger at the hands of respondent Nos. 4 & 5 and their relatives, by providing them security.

2. As per the case unfolded by the petitioners, they are major in age and have solemnized marriage on July 10, 2016. In support thereof, they have placed on record marriage certificate Annexure P-5 and photographs Annexures P-3 & P-4.

3. Without expressing any opinion on the validity of the marriage and keeping in view the mandate of the directions issued by the Hon'ble Apex Court in the case of **Lata Singh Vs. State of U.P.**

and another, JT 2006 (6) SC 173, the present petition is disposed of, with a direction to respondent No.2- Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar, District Jalandhar (Punjab) to look into the grievances narrated in their representation dated July 12, 2016 (Annexure P-6) and to take appropriate action in accordance with law to ensure that no harm is caused to the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents.

4. This order shall not be construed to be conferring the legitimacy or authenticity to the factum of marriage having been performed as well as their age, as the Court is clearly deprived of any means to determine the aforesaid facts.
