The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.17 dated 15.1.2016 under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 IPC, Police Station Sector 39, Chandigarh in view of compromise dated 2.2.2016 (Annexure P-3).

Notice in the present petition was issued on the ground that parties have settled their dispute as reflected in compromise dated 2.2.2016 (Annexure P-3) reached between the parties. During the course of the arguments, learned counsel for the respondents submits that the petitioner has breached the terms and conditions of the compromise and the amount of ₹2,40,000/- out of the total amount of ₹4,40,000/- is yet to be paid by him. However, the respondent will have

no objection in case the present petition is allowed and the remaining payment is made by the petitioner. As the compromise reached between the parties, is not honoured by the petitioner, therefore, no case for quashing of the FIR on the basis of compromise, is made out.

Dismissed.
