Petitioners claim that they have been granted bail by this Court but the official respondents at the instance of private individuals are unnecessarily interfering in the liberty of the petitioners.

Aggrieved by the harassment, a representation has been submitted to SSP, SBS Nagar, copy of which has been placed on record as annexure P-5.

Without expression of any opinion regarding the allegations in the petition, I deem it appropriate that the grievance of the petitioner can be

looked into by SSP, SBS Nagar, in order to ensure that life and liberty of an individual is not unnecessarily hampered without the process of law.

Notice to Advocate General, Punjab.

On the asking of the Court, Ms.Simsi Dhir Malhotra, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice. Copy given.

This petition is disposed of and it is ordered that the request of the petitioners for infringement of liberty by Banga Police will be looked into by the SSP, SBS Nagar, taking into consideration the constitutional right of liberty under Article 21 of the Constitution of India. It will be open to the said authorities to dispose of the matter at his own level. It will be appreciated in case the necessary action is done within a period of three months after the receipt of a certified copy of the order.
