Prayer in this petition is for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner, in a case arising out of F.I.R No. 49 of 18.6.2016 registered under Sections 406, 498-A, 506 and 120-B IPC and Sections 295, 25, 27, 54 and 59 of the Arms Act registered at P.S. Fattu Dyinga District Kapurthala.

Vide order dated 22.8.2016 parties were relegated to Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court for settlement of the dispute. As per report of the Mediation and Conciliation Centre, parties have settled their dispute by way of amicable settlement. Settlement/Agreement made dated 5.12.2016 between the parties is also annexed with the petition.

In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances of the case and Settlement/Agreement dated 5.12.2016 between the parties, petitioner is directed to be released on bail to the satisfaction of CJM/Duty Magistrate, Kapurthala.

The petitioner shall continue to join the investigation as and when required to do so and abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr. P.C.

However, the petitioner is at liberty to file fresh bail bonds after presentation of the challan.

Accordingly, the petition stands disposed of.
