The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.22 dated 06.05.2016, registered under Sections 341, 452, 509/34 IPC and Section 12 of the Prevention of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012, Police Station Sirsa, District Sirsa.

Counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner was arrested on 01.07.2016 and investigation is over, challan has been filed and charge has been framed. He also states that the anticipatory bail was granted to the wife and no role was given in the FIR but in the statement under Section 164 Cr.P.C., the victim had stated that the petitioner was holding a pistol but later Section 285 has been deleted.

The only allegation against the petitioner is that he threatened the complainant with the licenced pistol. No role was given in the FIR. The trial Court will examine as to whether there was any involvement.

Without commenting anything on the merits of the case and considering the fact that the trial will take time to conclude, the petition

is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on bail on his furnishing adequate bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate with the rider that the petitioner would not contact the prosecutrix or her family.
